

DAEP PARENT CONTRACT

PARENT/GUARDIAN:

In order for my child to attend the DAEP, I understand that I must agree with the following:

1. My child will follow the rules, policies, and procedures of the DAEP and Kerrville ISD Student Code of Conduct.
2. I will come to school when requested for conferences with teachers, counselors, and/or administrators. I agree to provide transportation in the event of my child’s removal from campus.
3. I understand that my child must attend school daily, or truancy will be filed.
4. I will review, sign, and return weekly progress reports (point sheets) each week. **FAILURE TO RETURN DAILY PROGRESS SHEETS ON MONDAY WILL RESULT IN A LOSS OF POINTS DAILY** until it is returned to DAEP staff. (Provide information to parent/guardian regarding what constitutes a “successful” day.)
5. I understand and support the dress code at Kerrville DAEP and take responsibility that my child will strictly obey or face disciplinary actions including point deductions, Removal from classroom, or suspension.
6. I understand that all contraband confiscated at DAEP will be held in accordance with handbook regulations. This includes cellphones, all electronic devices, and personal items.
7. My child may not be on any Kerrville ISD property or any other part of the alternative education campus. If this does occur, trespassing charges may be filed resulting in citation and/or arrest as well as other disciplinary actions. (This includes extracurricular activities such as sporting events, concerts, etc...)
8. I understand my child will recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag unless I notify the DAEP Principal in writing that he/she is not to do so.
9. If my child has any discipline problem on the bus, he/she will lose transportation privileges. Any other applicable rules related to transportation will also apply.
10. I give permission for my child’s school/discipline records to be released to Juvenile Probation authorities.
11. If my child fails to abide by policies and procedures outlined at the DAEP campus he/she may be subject to appropriate disciplinary action, behavior contract, and/or suspension/expulsion in accordance with Chapter 37.008 and district Student Code of Conduct.
12. I have received a 2015-2016 DAEP handbook and understand the expectations.
